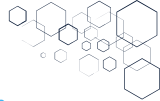

## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

March 2026 saw a continued rise in targeted attacks, supply chain compromises, and identity-based breaches.

Threat actors are increasingly leveraging legitimate tools and cloud platforms to bypass traditional security controls.



### Key Cyber Incidents

- European Commission – Cloud data breach (~350GB exfiltrated)
- Nordstrom – Email system abuse used for crypto scam
- Tycoon 2FA phishing platform dismantled
- Starbucks – Employee credential breach
- Stryker – Device wipe using Microsoft Intune/Entra ID
- Trivy – Supply chain compromise distributing malware



### Critical Vulnerabilities

Multiple high-severity vulnerabilities identified including Cisco Firewall RCE, Langflow RCE, Spring AI injection, Zoom privilege escalation, and Chrome memory exploit.

Immediate patching is strongly recommended.



### Ransomware Landscape

790 victims recorded globally in March.

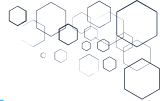
Manufacturing most targeted sector.

Top groups include Qilin, Akira, and DragonForce.



### Emerging Threats

Vect Ransomware (RaaS), Reynolds ransomware (BYOVD evasion), and WhoUser infostealer highlight growing sophistication.



## Phishing Trends

Campaigns continue to leverage legitimate infrastructure, archive attachments, and credential harvesting techniques.



## Strategic Insight

Threat actors are forming partnerships combining access brokers, ransomware groups, and underground forums, creating a full attack supply chain.



## Recommendations

- Patch critical vulnerabilities within 7 days
- Enforce MFA across all systems
- Deploy EDR and monitor identity platforms
- Conduct phishing awareness training
- Test backups and incident response plans



## Risk Assessment

Current Threat Level: HIGH

Primary risks include identity compromise, ransomware, supply chain attacks, and credential theft.
